

Permit for the PREMIUM complex granted to the ATENOR GROUP

ATENOR GROUP is delighted to be able to inform you that the permit for the PREMIUM complex was granted by the City of Brussels on June 24, 2010.

This major mixed urban project will be developed along the canal in the North District in Brussels, opposite the Tour&Taxis Royal Warehouse. It totals 1,972 m² of commercial space, 29,615 m² of offices and 48,435 m² of housing, of which 36,100 m² in a 42-floor tower with a height of 140 metres. Said tower will be the tallest residential tower in Belgium and one of the tallest in Europe.

This project is already an example of urban rehabilitation and redevelopment towards a sustainable city thanks to its mixed functionality and the environmental technology it incorporates.

The construction work will start as soon as possible and a press conference will be organised at the end of the summer to reveal the latest visuals and the model of this project which will be a milestone in the urban planning of Brussels and the development of the ATENOR GROUP.
